Dear Parents and Carers

Following the Government announcement made yesterday regarding school closure I would like to let you know how this may impact pupils, staff and parents at Haymerle School.

As a provision supporting pupils with education and health care plans we are working hard to follow guidance and remain open.

Over the past few weeks and particularly following yesterday's announcement the availability of our staff is now subject to significant change at very short notice. Many staff have needed to self-isolate, change availability to be able to care for their own children and soon we expect further impact in response to impending changes to public transport.

All of these issues will have a day to day impact on our schools ability to provide safe provision day to day.

What about school closures and staff absence?

In consultation with out Governing Body we have decided to manage our response as follows

- The Senior Leadership team will monitor staff capacity on a daily basis and take any necessary decisions about class or school closure based on the safety and well-being of staff and pupils.
- Where staff capacity is assessed as no longer safe, due to reduced availability of suitably skilled staff, the decision will be made to close a class until the risk can be properly managed.
- Where this is necessary parents will be told to keep their children at home until they are informed that the class is able to reopen.

Please help us to communicate with you

In these difficult and changing times we will do all in our capacity to meet the needs of the pupils and support parents and families.

I appreciate your positive feedback and support and I know, working together, we will manage this difficult and changing situation in the best interests of all concerned.

If you need to keep you child off school please follow the usual absence management procedures. Where you are concerned and need to self-isolate as a family report this to the school.

Unauthorised absence should not be a concern if you follow the school current absence management procedures and keep the school informed of reasons for absence. If you have a particular concern please call the school and we will try to return your call on the same day where ever possible.
