The New Normal

School Meals

Due to the limited space we cannot currently offer school meals served in the school dinner hall.

We will continue to offer a packed lunch school meal in autumn 2020 as this can be enjoyed in smaller break out spaces within the new social bubbles.

We work closely with our meal providers to secure a balanced nutritional lunchtime offer.

Where there are dietary or allergy issues these can be accommodated safely. Please ensure you keep our school office staff informed if there are any particular needs for your child.



Transport

We are working with the Southwark Transport Team to match the new social bubbles with bus rounds in time for September 2020. Please check for any messages from transport through the summer in case there are changes made to the bus rounds and times.
