ENGAGEMENT FOCUS activity 2: discovery

Explore and focus on discovery in a supported, prompted or independent capacity. Discovery is a new or repeated action or experience that causes realisation, surprise or excitement

It will enable us to monitor the progress in this area through eye contact, facial expression, use of voice, initiating play on an instrument and prompting a movement.

DISCOVERY





Step 1: Provide a few instruments and textures and place them on a table or tray that will become your child/pupil's Music Discovery Table. Increase the element of surprise by covering the items and introducing them one by one!

Step 2: Put on the below music that is full of expectation and anticipation and then stop! https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=HIIG2NKnsVA

Step 3: Reveal the items and allow your child/pupil to choose their preferred instrument or texture and provide up to 5 minutes exploration time using a visual countdown method

Step 4: Repeat the above steps and note any change in levels of discovery

Step 5: Has discovery heightened? Is there increased motivation and excitement once there is more familiarity with this activity? Does your child/pupil want to discover more?
